

- 3. To ratify the Audit Committee's appointment of PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP as our independent registered public accounting firm for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2014.

#### The Board of Directors recommends that you vote AGAINST Proposals 4, 5 and 6.

- 4. To consider and act upon a stockholder proposal concerning an independent board chairman, if properly presented at the Annual Meeting.
- 5. To consider and act upon a stockholder proposal concerning the adoption of proxy access, if properly presented at the Annual Meeting.
- 6. To consider and act upon a stockholder proposal concerning a policy regarding accelerated vesting of equity awards of senior executives upon a change in control, if properly presented at the Annual Meeting.
